17 18 19 20	Further amend the bill in section 1, in that part designated " $\S253$ ." by striking out the 2nd sentence (page 2, lines 20 to 23 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:
21 22 23 24	'The commission may adopt rules in accordance with the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, Title 5, chapter 375, as it deems necessary to conduct the affairs of the commission.'
25 26 27	Further amend the bill in section 1, in that part designated "§254." by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph and inserting in its place the following:
28 29 30 31 32 33 34 35 36 37	'The commissioners on the part of the State may, from time to time, meet with such commissioners as may be appointed for the same purposes and with substantially similar powers on the part of the state of New Hampshire to define and ascertain a common, lateral-marine boundary. The commissioners representing the State of Maine may agree to a just and reasonable location of a common lateral-marine boundary for the purpose of submission of a mutual written agreement to the Legislatures of Maine and New Hamp-

1 2 3 4	Further amend the bill in section 1, in that part designated "§255." by striking out all of the first sentence (page 3, lines 7 to 11 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:
5 6 7 8 ,9	'If, at a minimum, a majority of the commissioners from each state agree to the location of a common lateral-marine boundary as provided in this chapter, the agreement shall be established in writing as a compact and signed by a majority of the commissioners of each state.'
11 12 13	Further amend the bill in section 1, by striking out all of that part designated " $\S257$ ." and inserting in its place the following:
14	§257. Vacancy
15 16 17 18 19	If a vacancy in the commission occurs by death, resignation or other means with respect to a commissioner representing the State of Maine, the vacancy shall be filled by the appointing authority designated by this chapter to make that appointment.
20 21	Further amend the bill in section 1 by adding at the end the following:
22	'§259. Implementation of chapter
23 24 25 26 27 28	The provisions of this chapter shall not become effective and no members of the commission may be appointed until the state legislature of New Hampshire has enacted and the Governor of New Hampshire has approved legislation to establish the commission as defined in this chapter.

30	The purpose of this amendment is to make techni-

- members of the commission represent York County. In
- 3 addition, this amendment conditions the implementa-
- tion of the bill upon enactment of the legislation by 4 the New Hampshire state legislature and approval by 5
