STATE OF MAINE 3 4 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 5 112TH LEGISLATURE 6 FIRST REGULAR SESSION COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" 7 H.P. 1051, L.D. to 1527, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Extension of the Per-8 mit Processing Period for Hydropower Projects." 9 10 Amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause (page 1, 11 12 line 24 in L.D.) the following: 'Sec. 1.' 13 Further amend the bill in that part designated "§635-A." in the first paragraph, in the last 3 lines 14 (page 1, lines 33 to 35 in L.D.) by striking out the 15 following: "section 344, except that the commission-16 er may waive the requirements of section 344, only at 17 the request of the applicant" and inserting in its place the following: 'section 344, except that, fol-lowing one extension of up to 45 working days, the commissioner may waive the requirements of section 344, only at the request of the applicant' 18 19 20 21 22 23 Further amend the bill in that part designated " $\underline{\$635-A}$." in the 2nd paragraph in the last 5 lines (page 2, lines 5 to 9 in L.D.) by striking out the 24 25 26 following: "The director may waive the time limit re-27 quirements of this section only at the request of the 28 applicant. The time limit requirements may be waived 29 in the manner set out in section 344, subsection 4." 30 and inserting in its place the following: 'The Following one extension of up to 45 working days, the director may waive the time limit requirements of 31 32 33 this section only at the request of the applicant.' 34 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end 35 before the statement of fact the following:

Extention of the time limits for processing applications which have been properly filed with the board or the commission before COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " \mathcal{A} " to H.P. 1051, L.D. 1527 the effective date of this Act shall be governed by 1 2 the law in effect at the time the applications were 3 filed.' 4 STATEMENT OF FACT 5 The purpose of this amendment is to allow the Board of Environmental Protection and the Maine Land б 7 Use Regulation Commission to extend the time limit 8 for processing applications for hydropower projects for up to 45 days. After that, current law provides that the time limit may be waived only at the request 9 10 11 of the applicant. 4055053185 12
