22 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
23 lature do not become effective until 90 days after
24 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

25 Whereas, it appears that some insurance companies
26 doing business in this State are considering cancel-
27 ling appointments of certain of their agents because
28 they provide only a limited amount of insurance poli-
29 cy sales; and

30 Whereas, these cancellations, if actually imple-
31 mented, will significantly impair competition among
32 insurance companies in this State and will seriously
33 limit the selection of policies available to the gen-
34 eral public; and
