HOUSE AMENDMENT "*A*" to H.P. 1063, L.D. 1542,
Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Nomination Petitions for
Unenrolled Candidates."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the beginning of
the first line after the enacting clause (page 1, line
24 in L.D.) the following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the Bill by adding at the end be-
fore the Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 2. 21-A MRSA §354, sub-§5, as enacted by
PL 1985, c. 161, §6, is amended to read:

5. Number of signatures required. Nomination pe-
titions must be signed by the following numbers of
voters:

A. For a slate of candidates for the office of
presidential elector, at least ~~4,000~~ 2,000 and
not more than ~~6,000~~ 3,000 voters;

B. For a candidate for Governor, at least ~~4,000~~
2,000 and not more than ~~6,000~~ 3,000 voters;

C. For a candidate for United States Senator, at
least ~~4,000~~ 2,000 and not more than ~~6,000~~ 3,000
voters;

D. For a candidate for United States Representa-
tive, at least ~~2,000~~ 1,000 and not more than
~~3,000~~ 1,500 voters;

E. For a candidate for county office, at least
~~300~~ 150 and not more than ~~400~~ 200 voters;

F. For a candidate for State Senator, at least
