Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:							
Sec. 1. 34-B MRSA §3005 is enacted to read:

The Bureau of Mental Health shall establish a therapeutic residence program for persons who are deaf and in need of residential mental health treat- ment. The therapeutic residence program shall be op- erated in conjunction with existing rehabilitation, education, mental health treatment and housing re- sources.
