Oversight of legislative appropriations and accounts. To oversee the appropriations and other fi-18 19 nancial accounts of the Legislature and of all legis-20 lative agencies, departments and offices. Appropria-21 tions for carrying out the purposes of this chapter 22 shall be made annually by the Legislature. All appropriations or allocations by the Legislature for spe-23 24 cific studies to be carried out by the joint standing 25 committees or joint select committees shall not lapse 26 but shall be carried forward and expended for the 27 purpose for which the appropriation or allocation was made. The balance of any appropriation or allocation 28 29 for such studies that is not fully expended shall be 30 refunded to the Legislature;. 31 The Legislative Council shall establish budgets and 32 provide sufficient money from the Legislative Account 33 for studies to be conducted by joint standing committees, joint select committees and investigatory com-34 mittees of the Legislature. The budgets, at a mini-35 36 mum, shall include the following items: 37 A. Per diem compensation, if any, for each mem-

In de- termining the budgets, the Legislative Council shall consider the degree of difficulty of the tasks to be performed, the number of committee members and the number of meetings necessary to satisfactorily com- plete the tasks.
21 22 23	The Legislative Council may approve or disapprove studies, excluding studies approved by the Legisla-

23 ture requested by the joint standing committees of 24 the Legislature or individual Legislators;'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to allow the Legislative Council sufficient flexibility to oversee expenditures of committees of the Legislature and sufficient guidelines of expenditures for committees to follow in the conduct of their studies. The Legislative Council is required to establish budgets for the conduct of each study.
