to H.P. 1069, L.D. 1550, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning
the Forest Resources of Maine."

Amend the amendment in section 11, in subsection
3, by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

'Within the context of the comprehensive management
plan, the commissioner shall, in accordance with the
procedures of Title 5, chapter 375, adopt specific
action plans for each of the units of the public re-
served lands system. Each actions plan shall include
consideration of the related systems of silviculture
and regeneration of forest resources and shall pro-
vide for outdoor recreation, including wilderness,
timber, watershed protection, wildlife and fish. The
commissioner shall complete the action plans no later
than December 31, 1989, and shall revise them from
time to time as necessary. Management of the public
reserved lands prior to the completion of the action
plans shall be in accordance with all other provi-
sions of this section.'
