12 13 14 15 16 17 18 20 21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28 29	'Within the context of the comprehensive management plan, the commissioner shall, after adequate opportu- nity for public review and comment, adopt specific action plans for each of the units of the public re- served lands system. Each action plan shall include consideration of the related systems of silviculture and regeneration of forest resources and shall pro- vide for outdoor recreation, including remote, unde- veloped areas, timber, watershed protection, wildlife and fish. The commissioner shall complete the action plans no later than December 31, 1989, and shall re- vise them from time to time as necessary. The commis- sioner shall provide adequate opportunity for public review and comment on any substantial revision of an action plan. Management of the public reserved lands prior to the completion of the action plans shall be in accordance with all other provisions of this sec- tion.'
