HOUSE AMENDMENT "?" to H.P. 1073, L.D. 1562,
Bill, "AN ACT to Mandate a Course in Cardiopulmonary
Resuscitation in High Schools."

10 Amend the bill by striking out all of the title 11 and inserting in its place the following:

12 'AN ACT Concerning Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation In-13 struction in High Schools.'

14 Further amend the bill in section 1, in that part 15 designated "<u>§4723.</u>" by striking out all of the last 2 16 underlined sentences (page 1, lines 31 to 35 in L.D.) 17 and inserting in their place the following:

18 'The school board or committee for each public secondary school shall hold a public hearing during the 19 20 school year 1985-86 to determine if there is parental 21 or student interest for that secondary school to of-22 fer instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation as 23 part of a health curriculum. If instruction is of-24 fered, the schools, where possible, shall make use of 25 local voluntary rescue services or hospitals to pro-26 vide teaching aides and instructors.
