HOUSE AMENDMENT "^A" to H.P. 1073, L.D. 1562,
8 Bill, "AN ACT to Mandate a Course in Cardiopulmonary
9 Resuscitation in High Schools."

Amend the bill by striking out all of the title
11 and inserting in its place the following:

12

'AN ACT Concerning Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation In-
13 struction in High Schools.'

14

Further amend the bill in section 1, in that part
15 designated "§4723." by striking out all of the last 2
16 underlined sentences (page 1, lines 31 to 35 in L.D.)
17 and inserting in their place the following:

'The school board or committee for each public sec-
19 ondary school shall hold a public hearing during the
20 school year 1985-86 to determine if there is parental
21 or student interest for that secondary school to of-
22 fer instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation as
23 part of a health curriculum. If instruction is of-
24 fered, the schools, where possible, shall make use of
25 local voluntary rescue services or hospitals to pro-
26 vide teaching aides and instructors.'

1 STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this amendment is to require
3 school boards and committees to hold public hearings
4 to determine if parental or student interest exists
5 for instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation.
