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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1075, L.D. 1564, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide Expanded Markets for Products and Services from Rehabilitation Facilities and Work Centers."

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Amend the bill in section 3, in that part designated "§1826-C." in subsection 3, paragraph E, in the last line (page 5, line 3 in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "member" the following: 'in accordance with the same provisions and standards that apply to executive employees as described in Title 5, section 18'

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Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

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'Sec. 4. 5 MRSA §12004, sub-§8, ¶A, sub-¶(12-A) is enacted to read:

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STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this amendment is to incorporate
3 the Work Center Purchases Committee into the Maine
4 Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 379, which governs
5 the payment of compensation and expenses of members
6 of boards and commissions. In addition, this amend-
7 ment subjects the purchasing committee to the stan-
8 dards that apply to state employees with respect to
9 conflict of interest.
