Amend the bill in that part designated "§5283."
in the first paragraph, by striking out all of the
last underlined sentence (page 1, lines 29 to 33 in
L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Every individual resident, who is entitled to no re-
fund under this Part, may contribute to any specified
political party, as defined in Title 21, section 1,
by including with his return sufficient funds to make
the contribution.'

This amendment removes the provision in current
law that a contribution pursuant to this section con-
stitutes tax liability.
