HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A"
to S.P. 598, L.D. 1568, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Li-
ability for Injuries Caused by Drunken Persons."

Amend the amendment in the 4th line after the ti-
tle (page 1, line 13 in amendment) by inserting at
the beginning of the line the following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the amendment by inserting before
the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 2. Sunset provision. This Act is repealed
on September 30, 1987.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds a "sunset" provision to make
sure the changes made in the committee amendment do
not become permanent solutions without further legis-
lative action. The Joint Standing Committee on Legal
Affairs plans to study the whole area of liquor lia-
bility and develop more comprehensive legislation.
The changes in the committee amendment are meant to
only fill in the gaps for the restaurant and
innkeeping industry until then.
