SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A"
to S.P. 598, L.D. 1568, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Li-
ability for Injuries Caused by Drunken Persons."

Amend the amendment by inserting at the beginning
of the first line after the 2nd paragraph, (page 1,
line 13 in amendment) the following:

'Sec. 1.'

Amend the amendment by inserting before the
statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 2. 28 MRSA §204, first ¶, as repealed and
replaced by PL 1983, c. 824, Pt. W, is repealed and
the following enacted in its place:

All persons except public service corporations
operating interstate, licensed to sell spirituous or
vinous liquor, except table wine, shall purchase all
such liquor from the commission.

Sec. 3. Sunset provision. Section 1 of this Act
is repealed on September 30, 1987.

Sec. 4. Effective date. Section 2 of this Act
shall take effect on October 1, 1985.
