1 the equivalent state seed generation. Imported seed 2 potatoes, where the generation cannot be demon-3 strated, shall be eligible for certification for no 4 more than one generation of in-state propagation.

5 Notwithstanding the foregoing, the commissioner 6 shall designate as experimental those seed potato va-7 rieties and seedlings which originally derive from sources other than the State's seed potato farm or 8 9 another known nuclear seed generation source; provided that the designation shall not be applied to 10 11 seed potatoes of a variety or seedling which were 12 certified on more than 100 acres in the immediately 13 preceding growing year; and provided further that 14 seed potatoes, once designated as experimental, shall 15 be subject to certification for up to 7 generations as long as all other certification requirements con-16 17 tinue to be met.

18 No seed potato may be designated "eertified seed" 19 <u>certified</u> which has not been winter tested. Seed 20 shipped before winter test results are available will 21 be "certified" based on field certification.

The commissioner may withhold from certification for in-state sales for that year any seed potatoes grown on a farm on which bacterial ring rot has been detected.

The commissioner may, upon application of one or more growers, and for good cause, temporarily waive either any or all of these requirements.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this new draft is to uphold and clarify the purposes of the State's seed potato certification program, while providing for an extended "flush-out" program for experimental varieties of seed potatoes.
