(1) All state agencies and departments shall cooperate with and expeditiously respond to the requests of the State Development Office. Each organization required by this subchapter to cooperate with the State Development Office shall, at a minimum, provide the State Development Office with descriptions of licenses and permits issued by each organization, the criteria necessary to qualify for each license or permit granted by the organization, time schedules established by law or rule for the submission of applications and appeals, the time schedules for agency responses to applications and appeals and any other information requested by the State Development Office.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This new draft removes the master licensing pro-20 21 posal and retains the provisions for a directory of 22 business licenses and permits that is part of the 23 original bill. According to this new draft, the Di-24 rector of the State Development Office is required to 25 update and publish annually a directory of licenses and permits required for new and expanding busi-nesses. The directory would show the licenses and 26 27 permits issued by each agency and the licenses and permits required of various types of business enter-28 29 30 prise and business activities. All state agencies are 31 required to cooperate with the Director of the State 32 Development Office and provide the director with the 33 necessary information.

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
