19 AN ACT to Establish a Directory of Licenses
20 and Permits Required of New and
21 Expanding Businesses.

23 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
24 follows:

25 Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §7002, sub-§2, ¶K, as enacted by
26 PL 1983, c. 135 and c. 519, §1, is repealed.

27 Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §7002, sub-§2, ¶L is enacted to
28 read:

29 L. The director shall implement a program de-
30 signed to create and publish a directory or guide
31 of state licenses and permits required for vari-
32 ous types of new or expanding businesses. This
33 directory, which shall be updated annually, shall
34 delineate the business licenses and permits by
35 the name of the agency that issues the licenses

1 and permits, by the type of business or industry
2 and by the type of activity involved.

3 (1) All state agencies and departments
4 shall cooperate with and expeditiously re-
5 spond to the requests of the State Develop-
6 ment Office. Each organization required by
7 this subchapter to cooperate with the State
8 Development Office shall, at a minimum, pro-
9 vide the State Development Office with de-
10 scriptions of licenses and permits issued by
11 each organization, the criteria necessary to
12 qualify for each license or permit granted
13 by the organization, time schedules estab-
14 lished by law or rule for the submission of
15 applications and appeals, the time schedules
16 for agency responses to applications and ap-
17 peals and any other information requested by
18 the State Development Office.

19 STATEMENT OF FACT

20 This new draft removes the master licensing pro-
21 posal and retains the provisions for a directory of
22 business licenses and permits that is part of the
23 original bill. According to this new draft, the Di-
24 rector of the State Development Office is required to
25 update and publish annually a directory of licenses
26 and permits required for new and expanding busi-
27 nesses. The directory would show the licenses and
28 permits issued by each agency and the licenses and
29 permits required of various types of business enter-
30 prise and business activities. All state agencies are
31 required to cooperate with the Director of the State
32 Development Office and provide the director with the
33 necessary information.

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
