1 STATEMENT OF FACT

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Teachers at private special education facilities must be certified like teachers in public schools, and the schools themselves are approved by the same process as public schools. The schools serve public school tuition students and special needs students referred by state agencies. In effect, these schools are an extension of the State's public school system, and their teachers should be eligible for the teacher recognition grants like their public school counterparts.
