HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1090, L.D. 1583,
Bill, "AN ACT to Require Adequate Notice of Tax Lien
Foreclosure."

Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all
of the 3rd, 4th and 5th lines from the end (page 2,
lines 19 to 21 in L.D.) and inserting in their place
the following:

'If you cannot pay the property taxes you owe
please contact me to discuss this notice.'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in the 3rd
line (page 2, line 26 in L.D.) by striking out the
following: ", 943"

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to eliminate the
requirement that the final tax lien notice contain a
statement that people may apply for abatement due to
poverty or infirmity. The 30-day notice required in
section 942 would have to contain such a statement.
