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STATEMENT OF FACT

This new draft revises the original language in the bill to comply with the recodification of the election laws enacted by Public Law 1985, chapter lol. It also ensures that voters who register outside of their county commissioner districts will not lose their vote for commissioner. In that case, a proper ballot will be provided by the county commissioners.

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
