21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 38 MRSA §419, sub-§1, ¶C, as enacted by PL 1971,
24 c. 544, §128, is amended to read:

25 C. "High phosphorous detergent", as used in this
26 section, means any detergent, presoak, soap,
27 enzyme or other cleaning agent containing more
28 than 8.7% phosphorous, by weight, but does not
29 include detergent having a recommended use level
30 which contains less than 7 grams of phosphorous
31 by weight.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to specifically exclude detergent having a recommended use level which contains less than 7 grams of phosphorous by weight for the definition of high phosphorous detergent.

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
