SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 605, L.D. 1599,
8 Bill, "AN ACT to Amend Certain Motor Vehicle Laws."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 9
10 and inserting in its place the following:

11 'Sec. 9. 29 MRSA §102, as amended by PL 1981, c.
12 346, §2, is further amended by adding at the end 2
13 new paragraphs to read:

14 The mileage requirement under this section shall
15 apply only to vehicles which are required titling
16 pursuant to chapter 21.

17 No trailer may be towed or remain upon any way,
18 unless the trailer is registered and equipped in ac-
19 cordance with this Title, except that a permit may be
20 granted at and by a municipal police department,
21 sheriff's office, State Police Regional Communication
22 Center or field office or an office of the Division
23 of Motor Vehicles to tow an unregistered trailer with
24 a gross weight of not more than 3,000 pounds, for one
25 trip only, between the points of origin and destina-
26 tion. The permit shall not remain valid for more than
27 3 consecutive days, including the date of issuance.
28 The application shall include the name of the appli-
29 cant, residence and address of the applicant, a brief
30 description of the trailer, the name of its maker and
31 the points of origin and destination.
