SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to S.P. 605, L.D. 1599,
Bill, "AN ACT to Amend Certain Motor Vehicle Laws."

Amend the bill by inserting before the emergency
clause the following:

'Sec. 23. Allocation. The following funds are
allocated from the Highway Fund in order to carry out
the purposes of this Act.

Further amend the bill by inserting after the
emergency clause the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

Section 15 of this bill requires that persons
over 65 years of age obtain a "photograph" license.
This measure will increase Highway Fund revenues by
\$60,000 in fiscal year 1986 and \$80,000 in fiscal
year 1987. The Division of Motor Vehicles will need
a Highway Fund allocation of \$18,000 in fiscal year
1986 and \$24,000 in fiscal year 1987 to cover the in-
creased costs for providing the photograph licenses.'

The purpose of this amendment is to add an allo-
