- 8 15. Vehicles required to be registered under section 2243, subsection 3. Those vehicles required to register under 2243, subsection 3, shall be exempt from requirements to title, so long as a currently effective certificate of title has been issued in another state. Proof of title shall be in a manner prescribed by the Secretary of State.'
- 15 Further amend the Bill by inserting before the emergency clause the following:
 - 'Sec. 23. Transition provision. The Maine Revised Statutes, Title 29, section 245-A shall not impair or limit the duration of validity of any registration issued under that section prior to the effective date of section 11. Any registration issued to a corporation organized under the laws of this State, prior to the effective date of section 11, shall be deemed to be a registration issued to a resident of this State as of the date of the issuance. Any registration issued to a foreign corporation, prior to the effective date of section 11, shall be deemed to be a registration issued to a resident of this State as of the date of the issuance if, at any time prior to or after the effective date of section 11, the foreign corporation has registered to do business in this State pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 13-A, chapter 12.'
- Further amend the Bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.
