 This new draft amends the recodified election laws to require a minimum number of voting booths depending on how large the population of the municipality. For municipalities of 4,000 or more, there must be at least one voting booth for every 150, or fraction exceeding 1/2 of that number, people qualified to vote there. In municipalities of less than 4,000, the municipal officer must provide at least one booth for every 200, or fraction exceeding 1/2 of that number, registered voters. Municipalities have the authority to add more booths if needed.
