7 SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 613, L.D. 1606, 8 Bill, "AN ACT to Provide Protections to Boxers."

9 Amend the Bill by striking out all of sections 1, 10 2, 4 and 5

11 Further amend the Bill in section 6 by striking 12 out all of paragraph C and inserting in its place the 13 following:

14 'C. The commission may adopt rules requiring 15 health and accident insurance providing coverage 16 in the event of injury or death for persons com-17 peting in boxing events subject to this chapter 18 or for persons competing in or wrestling events subject to this chapter, or for both. This insur-19 ance, if required, shall comply with standards 20 21 prescribed by the Superintendent of Insurance.'

22 Further amend the Bill by striking out all of 23 section 7.

Further amend the Bill in section 8 in that part designated "<u>§147-A.</u>" by striking out all of subsection 1 and inserting in its place the following:

27 '1. Headgear. No amateur boxing contests, exhibitions or sparring may take place in this State, unless the boxers wear protective headgear approved by the commission.'

31 Further amend the Bill in section 8 in that part 32 designated "§147-A." in subsection 2 in the 2nd, 3rd 33 and 4th lines (page 4, lines 12, 13 and 14 in L.D.) 34 by striking out the following: ", or amateur or pro-35 fessional kick-boxing contests, exhibitions or 36 sparring"

Not participate in any boxing contest or exhibition until the commission is presented with a 20 written certification of a licensed physician 21 22 that the boxer is fit to take part in competitive 23 boxing. Further amend the Bill in section 8 in that part designated " $\frac{147-B}{16}$ " in subsection 2 in the 4th line 24 25 (page 5, line 16 in L.D.) by striking out the follow-26 ing: "or kick boxer's" and in the 2nd and 3rd lines from the end (page 5, lines 18 and 19 in L.D.) by 27 28 striking out the underlined words "or kick boxer" and 29 in the last line (page 5, line 20 in L.D.) by strik-30 ing out the following: 'or kick-boxing' 31

32 Further amend the Bill in section 8 in that part 33 designated "<u>§147-B</u>." in subsection 3 in the 3rd and 34 4th lines (page 5, lines 23 and 24 in L.D.) by strik-

7 The purpose of this amendment is to remove all 8 references to kick boxing from the bill. The amend- 9 ment retains the provisions relating to the protec- 10 tion of boxers through use of headgear and other 11 safety equipment.
