Amend the resolve in section 1, in the 5th line
by inserting after the word and punctuation "sec-
tion." the following: 'The proceeds of the sales au-
thorized by this section shall be credited to the Un-
organized Territory Education and Services Fund.'

This amendment provides that the proceeds of the
sale of property acquired by the State as the result
of unpaid property taxes in the unorganized territory
shall be credited to the Unorganized Territory Educa-
tion and Services Fund. The fund is where the taxes
would have been credited if they had been paid.
