1 Whereas, unless that authorization is given, the 2 county commissioners will be unable to make modifica-3 tions to the jail facility to increase capacity; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

10 Authorization; expenditure for revenue generated 11 through inmate board. Resolved: That the Somerset 12 County commissioners shall be authorized to expend а 13 sum not to exceed \$130,000 from revenue generated 14 through inmate board during 1984 and 1985 to make 15 necessary modifications to the Somerset County jail 16 to increase the jails rated inmate capacity.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

21 The purpose of this resolve is to authorize the 22 Somerset County commissioners to use funds raised 23 through boarding inmates from other counties and the 24 State, to make modifications to the jail facility to 25 increase the jail's inmate rated capacity.

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
