24 25 26	This amendment increases the total number of dis- count liquor stores which may be established to 7: Six stores in addition to the Kittery store.

It is estimated that \$1,250,000 will be generated annually as a result of establishing 6 new discount HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to H.P. 1119, L.D. 1615

liquor stores. This is based on an anticipated \$5,000,000 of new liquor sales, the net profit of which is approximately 25%. The amount of General Fund revenue generated in fiscal year 1985-86 is too difficult to be determined at this time.
