HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to H.P. 1119, L.D. 1615,
Bill, "AN ACT to Further Competition in the Liquor
Trade."

Amend the bill in the first paragraph, in the 9th
sentence (page 2, line 27 in L.D.) by striking out
the following: "6" and inserting in its place the
following: '7'

Further amend the bill in the first paragraph by
inserting after the 9th sentence the following:

'Of the additional discount liquor stores, no more
than one may be located in any county.'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the
statement of fact the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

1986-87

General Fund \$1,250,000'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment increases the total number of dis-
count liquor stores which may be established to 7:
Six stores in addition to the Kittery store.

Of the additional discount liquor stores, no more
than one may be located in any county.

It is estimated that \$1,250,000 will be generated
annually as a result of establishing 6 new discount

1 liquor stores. This is based on an anticipated
2 \$5,000,000 of new liquor sales, the net profit of
3 which is approximately 25%. The amount of General
4 Fund revenue generated in fiscal year 1985-86 is too
5 difficult to be determined at this time.
