SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to H.P. 1120, L.D. 1616,  
8 Bill, "AN ACT Renaming Registered Day Care Providers  
9 as Home Baby-sitting Service Providers."

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part design-  
11 nated "§8305." by striking out all of subsection 2  
12 and inserting in its place the following:

13

'2. Complaints. Upon receipt of a complaint,  
14 the department may, if it has reasonable cause to  
15 suspect that a violation of the certification re-  
16 quirements has occurred, investigate complaints  
17 against the provider and shall have the right of en-  
18 try at any reasonable time for the purposes of the  
19 investigation.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

21

This amendment clarifies the law with regard to  
22 the department's authority to investigate complaints  
23 by specifying that the department must have reason-  
24 able cause to suspect that a violation of the certi-  
25 fication requirements has occurred.
