| 23 24 | Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: |
| 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34 35 36 37 | Boundary line. The boundary line between the Town of Clinton in the County of Kennebec and the Town of Pittsfield in the County of Somerset shall commence at a granite monument marked "TL" at the northwesterly corner of the Town of Burnham in the County of Waldo, as said northwesterly corner is de- fined by Private and Special Law 1983, chapter 66; thence North eleven degrees, fifty-three minutes, thirty seconds West (N 11-53-30 W) passing through the monuments identified on the plan hereinafter ref- erenced, a distance of three thousand six hundred fifty-nine and two tenths feet (3,659.2') to a gran- ite monument marked "TL"; thence South seventy-nine |

1 degrees, twenty-six minutes, zero seconds East (S 2 79-26-00 E) passing through a monument shown the on 3 plan hereinafter referenced, a distance of two thou-4 sand eight hundred ninety-five and seven tenths feet 5 (2,895.7') to a granite monument marked "TL"; thence 6 North ten degrees, forty-one minutes, zero seconds 7 (N 10-41-00 E) passing through a monument shown East 8 on the plan hereinafter referenced, a distance of two thousand seven hundred ninety-eight and nine tenths 9 10 (2,798.9') to a granite monument marked "TL", feet found on the southerly side of a public roadway 11 10-12 cally known as Johnson Flat Road. The Town of Pitts-13 field in the County of Somerset being on the generally easterly side of said boundary and the Town of 14 15 Clinton in the County of Kennebec being on the gener-16 ally westerly side of said boundary.

17 Bearings referenced in the above description are ori-18 ented to Grid North; Maine State Coordinate System 19 (1927); East Zone.

The within described boundary being the same shown on a plan entitled "Survey Plan of a Portion of the Corporate Boundary between Town of Pittsfield - Somerset County and Town of Clinton - Kennebec County", dated April 11, 1985, prepared by PLISGA & DAY, Land Surveyors to be recorded in the Somerset County and Kennebec County Registries of Deeds.

STATEMENT OF FACT

28 The purpose of this bill is to define and describe with greater certainty the location of a por-29 tion of the common boundary between the Towns 30 of 31 Clinton and Pittsfield between the northerly line of 32 the Town of Burnham and the public roadway known as Johnson Flat Road. 33

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
