HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1113, L.D. 1623,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Extend the Boundaries of the Gray  
Water District to Include the Entire Town."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after  
the enacting clause and inserting in its place the  
following:

'Sec. 1. P&SL 1929, c. 33, §1 is repealed and  
the following enacted in its place:

Sec. 1. Territorial limits; corporate name; pur-  
poses. Subject to section 13 hereof, the Town of  
Gray and the people therein shall constitute a public  
municipal corporation under the name of "Gray Water  
District" for the purpose of supplying the Town of  
Gray and the inhabitants of the town and the village  
corporations therein located, with pure water for do-  
mestic, manufacturing, sanitary and municipal pur-  
poses.

Sec. 2. Referendum; effective date. This Act  
shall be submitted to the legal voters of the Town of  
Gray at the next regular town meeting following pas-  
sage of this Act or at a special town meeting to be  
called and held for the purpose, no sooner than 90  
days nor more than 1 year following adjournment of  
the First Regular Session of the 112th Legislature.  
Warrants shall be issued for this town meeting in the  
manner now provided by law for the holding of town  
meetings, notifying the qualified voters of Gray to  
meet to vote on the approval or rejection of this  
Act.

The town clerk shall prepare the required bal-  
lots, on which he shall reduce the subject matter of  
this Act to the following question:

1 "Shall the boundaries of the Gray Water District  
2 be extended to include the entire town?"

3 The voters shall indicate by a cross or check  
4 mark placed against the words "Yes" or "No" their  
5 opinion of the question.

6 The results of the vote shall be declared by the  
7 municipal officers of that town and due certificate  
8 thereof shall be filed by the town clerk with the  
9 Secretary of State.

10 This Act shall be deemed approved by the Town of  
11 Gray upon its acceptance by a majority of the legal  
12 voters of that town voting at that election, provided  
13 that the total number of votes cast for and against  
14 the acceptance of this Act in that town at that elec-  
15 tion equals or exceeds 20% of the total vote for all  
16 candidates for Governor in that town at the next pre-  
17 vious gubernatorial election.

18 This Act shall take effect upon its approval by a  
19 majority of the legal voters of the Town of Gray vot-  
20 ing at that election, provided that, in no event, may  
21 this Act take effect sooner than 90 days following  
22 the adjournment of the First Regular Session of the  
23 112th Legislature.'
