HOUSE AMENDMENT "*A*" to H.P. 1115, L.D. 1625,
8 Bill, "AN ACT Increasing the Authorized Indebtedness
9 of Veazie Sewer District."

10

Amend the bill after the enacting clause by in-
11 serting in the first line of the amending clause
12 (page 2, line 9 in L.D.) the following:

13

'Sec. 1.'

14

Further amend the bill by striking out all of the
15 emergency clause and inserting in its place the fol-
16 lowing:

17

'Sec. 2. Emergency clause; referendum; effective
18 date. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble,
19 this Act shall take effect when approved only
20 for the purpose of submission to the legal voters of
21 the Veazie Sewer District in referendum.

This Act shall be submitted to the legal voters
23 of the Veazie Sewer District at the annual district
24 meeting in 1985 or 1986, or at a special district
25 meeting to be called and held for the purpose within
26 365 days of the approval of this Act. That special
27 district meeting shall be called, advertised and con-
28 ducted according to the law relating to municipal
29 elections, provided that the selectmen of the town
30 shall not be required to prepare for posting, nor the
31 town clerk to post, a new list of voters and for the
32 purpose of registration of voters the board of voter
33 registration shall be in session on the secular day
34 next preceding the special election. The town clerk
35 of the town shall prepare the required ballots, on
36 which he shall reduce the subject matter of this Act
37 to the following question:

1 "Shall the debt limit of the Veazie Sewer Dis-
2 trict be increased to \$1,000,000?"

3 The voters shall indicate by a cross or check
4 mark placed against the words "yes" or "No" their
5 opinion of the same.

6 This Act shall take effect for all purposes imme-
7 diately upon its acceptance by a majority of the le-
8 gal voters voting at the election; and further pro-
9 vided that the total number of votes cast for and
10 against the acceptance of this Act equals or exceeds
11 20% of the total vote for all candidates for Governor
12 cast in the Town of Veazie at the next previous gu-
13 bernatorial election.

14 The result of the vote shall be declared by the
15 municipal officers of the Town of Veazie and due cer-
16 tificate shall be filed by the town clerk with the
17 Secretary of State.'

18 STATEMENT OF FACT

19 This amendment adds a local referendum.
