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- Sec. 3. Bonds. To provide funds for renovations and additions to the jail, the treasurer Aroostook County, with the approval of the county commissioners, may borrow from time to time upon the full faith and credit of the county such sums not exceeding in the aggregate \$2,100,000 as may be necessary, and may issue self-liquidating bonds therefor which shall bear on their face the words "Aroostook County Capital Improvement Bonds Act of 1985." authorized issue shall be payable in such annual installments, beginning not more than 2 years the date thereof and not earlier than the year 1987, as will extinguish each loan in not more than years from its date. The bonds shall be signed by the treasurer of the county and countersigned by the majority of the county commissioners. The county may sell these securities at public or private sale upon such terms and conditions as the county commissioners may deem proper, but at not less than par and accrued interest.
- Sec. 4. Temporary notes. The county treasurer, with the approval of the county commissioners, may issue temporary notes of the county, payable in not more than one year from their dates, in anticipation of the issue of serial bonds under this Act and may renew the same, but the time within which these serial bonds shall become due and payable shall not, by reason of these temporary notes, be extended beyond the term fixed by this Act. Any notes issued in anticipation of the serial bonds shall be paid from the proceeds thereof.
- Sec. 5. Referendum for ratification. This Act shall be submitted to the legal voters of Aroostook County. The date of submission shall be at the discretion of the Aroostook County Board of Commissioners, but not later than 24 months after adjournment of the Legislature. Aroostook County Commissioners are authorized to expend such funds as are necessary to implement the referendum.

The county commissioners shall cause the preparation of the required ballots on which they shall state the subject matter of this Act in the following question:

"Shall the issuance of bonds be authorized in an amount not to exceed \$2,100,000 for renovations and additions to the Aroostook County jail?"

The voters shall indicate by a cross or check mark placed against the words "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same.

This Act shall take effect for all the purposes hereof immediately upon its acceptance by a majority of the legal voters voting at the election; provided the total number of votes cast for and against the acceptance of this Act equals or exceeds 30% of the total votes for all candidates for Governor cast in the next previous gubernatorial election in that county. If, at any such first election, the total number of votes cast for or against acceptance of this Act is less than 30% of the total votes for all candidates for Governor cast in that county in the next previous gubernatorial election, the county commissioners may call not more than one other such special election to be held within the time prescribed above.

The result of such elections shall be declared by the Aroostook County Commissioners and due certificate filed with the Secretary of State.

29 STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to authorize a bond issue in the amount of \$2,100,000 for renovations and additions to the Aroostook County Jail. This issue is subject to ratification by the voters of Aroostook County.

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
