Any vacancy in the board caused by death, resignation or removal of any member shall be 5 filled by the appointment of a person qualified, to hold office during the unexpired term of the member whose place is thus filled. Any member of the board may be removed from office for cause, by the Gover-6 7 nor. The members of the board shall each be compen-9 sated according to the provisions of Title 5, chapter 10 11 379. The board may examine and license plumbers. 12 Further amend the Bill in section 2 in the last line (page 2, line 20 in L.D.) by inserting after the word "expires" the following: '; except that if the 13 14 professional member whose term is expiring is eligi-15 ble for reappointment and the appointing authority 16 wishes to make a reappointment of that member, the 17 18 appointing authority may appoint that member for one 19 additional term' 20 Further amend the Bill by renumbering the sec-21 tions to read consecutively. 22 STATEMENT OF FACT 23 The Plumbers' Examining Board is increased to 5 members so that the 2 public members will not consti-24 25 tute a majority on the board. amendment also allows for a delay in the ap-26 The
