Any vacancy in the board caused by death, resignation or removal of any member shall be filled by the appointment of a person qualified, to hold office during the unexpired term of the member whose place is thus filled. Any member of the board may be removed from office for cause, by the Governor. The members of the board shall each be compensated according to the provisions of Title 5, chapter 379. The board may examine and license plumbers.'
12 13	Further amend the Bill by striking out all of section 2
14	STATEMENT OF FACT
15 16 17	The Plumbers' Examining Board is increased to 5 members so that the 2 public members will not constitute a majority on the board.
18 19	The amendment also increases the membership of the Auctioneers Advisory Board from 3 to 5 years.
20 21	The amendment removes the section of bill requiring a board report to the Legislature.
