18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25	The purpose of this amendment is to prohibit dis- crimination based upon handicap and to continue the present law which is that handicapped workers, like all workers, are entitled to compensation for total disability based on 2/3 of wage loss subject to the minimum of \$25. The State's minimum \$25 per week ben- efit is approximately 45th lowest out of the 50 states.
