11 tions to read consecutively

12 STATEMENT OF FACT

13 This amendment makes technical changes to the
14 bill to provide that appropriations, equipment, prop-
15 erty and funds of the vocational-technical institutes
16 are transferred to the Maine Vocational-technical In-
17 stitutes Administration. This amendment also corrects
18 the appropriations section, but does not change the
19 total figures in order to reflect the changes at each
20 institute.

21 This amendment removes section 1 of the bill
22 which establishes the pay range for the Executive Di-
23 rector of the Maine Vocational-technical Institutes
24 Administration with other state agency officials.
25 Since the executive director is not a state employee,
26 the pay range cannot be established in the laws re-
27 lating to the state officials.
