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HOUSE AMENDMENT "**A**" to H.P. 1145, L.D. 1652,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Promote Industrial Stability."

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Amend the bill in section 1, in that part designated "§1036," in subsection 1, by inserting at the end the following:

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'G. The qualifying applicant shall repay to the fund an amount equal to the assistance provided under this subchapter plus interest if, prior to July 1, 1990, the applicant reduces its labor force by more than 50% as reported for the quarter ending June 30, 1985, to the Maine Bureau of Employment Security, or ceases manufacturing operations at its Maine facilities. Interest shall be computed in accordance with Title 36, section 186, as though the assistance provided was owed in back taxes. The authority shall exercise its powers under Title 10, chapter 110, to ensure the State's interests under this paragraph are protected.'

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1145, L.D. 1652

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment provides that if a qualifying facility substantially reduces or ceases its manufacturing operations in Maine prior to July 1, 1990, then all assistance provided shall be repayed with interest.
