19 AN ACT to Provide Supplemental Appropriations
20 to the Legislature.

22 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
23 lature do not become effective until 90 days after
24 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

25 Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate un-
26 til after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

27 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses will
28 become due and payable immediately; and

29 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
30 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
31 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
32 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
33 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
34 therefore,

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
2 follows:

3 Appropriation. The following funds are appropri-
4 ated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes
5 of this Act.

9 All Other \$250,000

10 Funds for this that
11 were included in the
12 Part II budget will
13 automatically lapse
14 to the General Fund
15 because the emergency
16 clause was not in-
17 cluded. This bill
18 has no net additional
19 cost to the General
20 Fund.

21 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited
22 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-
23 proved.

24 STATEMENT OF FACT

25 The purpose of this bill is to make supplemental
26 appropriations to the Legislature for obligations and
27 expenses that will become due and payable immediate-
28 ly.
