20 Collective Bargaining Agreements.

22 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
23 lature do not become effective until 90 days after
24 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

25 Whereas, the 90-day period will not terminate un-
26 til after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

27 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses inci-
28 dent to the operation of state collective bargaining
29 agreements will become due and payable immediately;
30 and

31 Whereas, it is the responsibility of the Legisla-
32 ture to act upon those portions of tentative collec-
33 tive bargaining agreements negotiated by the Execu-
34 tive Branch which require legislative action; and

1 of Education and the Vocational-technical Institute
2 Administrators Bargaining Unit for fiscal year 1986
3 and fiscal year 1987.

4 Section 1 provides an allocation to fund the col-
5 lective bargaining agreement.

6 Section 2 provides an authorization for the ap-
7 proval and use of funds.

8 Section 3 provides for the adjustment of salary
9 schedules by an increase of 3 1/2% effective the pay
10 week closest to July 1, 1985, for bargaining unit
11 members.

12 Section 4 provides for the adjustment of the then
13 current salary schedules by an increase of 1 1/2% ef-
14 fective the pay week closest to January 1, 1986, for
15 bargaining unit members.

16 Section 5 provides for the equitable treatment of
17 probationary and other employees in classification
18 within the Vocational-technical Institute Administra-
19 tors Bargaining Unit.

20 Part B of this bill provides for any unspent
21 funds to carry forward until June 30, 1987.
