22 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
23 lature do not become effective until 90 days after
24 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

25 Whereas, reform legislation was passed on an
26 emergency basis at the First Regular Session of the
27 112th Legislature regarding workers' compensation;
28 and

29 Whereas, those emergency reforms include a reha-
30 bilitation program; and

31 Whereas, the rehabilitation program must be set
32 up immediately in order to cover injuries occurring
33 on and after January 1, 1986; and
