15 16 17	IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE
18 19 20 21 22	AN ACT to Allow the Finance Authority of Maine to Close any Project Initiated Prior to the Recent Changes in Finance Authority of Maine Legislation.
23 24 25	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis- lature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
26 27 28 29	Whereas, the Legislature passed at the First Regular Session of the 112th Legislation which elimi- nated the Finance Authority of Maine's role in pro- viding bond funds for housing;
30 31 32 33	Whereas, the Legislature inadvertently failed to except one project which had already obtained approv- al from the authority prior to the effective date of that new legislation;
34 35 36	Whereas, this legislation is urgently needed to provide that exemption to avoid needless litigation; and

1 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 2 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 3 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 4 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-5 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 6 therefore,

7 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 8 follows:

9 Application. The Maine Revised Statutes, Title 10 10, section 1041-A, subsection 5, does not apply with 11 respect to any project for which the Finance Authori-12 ty of Maine has issued a certificate of approval pri-13 or to September 19, 1985.

14 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency 15 cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect 16 when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

18 This bill allows the Finance Authority of Maine 19 to complete any project for which it issued a certif-20 icate of approval prior to September 19, 1985. The 21 effective date of Public Law 1985, chapter 344, which 22 eliminated FAME'S role in providing bond funds for 23 housing.
