23 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
24 lature do not become effective until 90 days after
25 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

26 Whereas, the Legislature passed at the First
27 Regular Session of the 112th Legislation which elimi-
28 nated the Finance Authority of Maine's role in prov-
29 iding bond funds for housing;

30 Whereas, the Legislature inadvertently failed to
31 except one project which had already obtained approv-
32 al from the authority prior to the effective date of
33 that new legislation;

34 Whereas, this legislation is urgently needed to
35 provide that exemption to avoid needless litigation;
