18 AN ACT to Clarify the Referendum Provision
19 to Revise and Modernize the Charter of
20 the York Sewer District.

22 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
23 lature do not become effective until 90 days after
24 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

25 Whereas, the referendum provision of P&SL 1985,
26 c. 57 needs to be clarified; and

27 Whereas, it is vitally important to clarify the
28 referendum provision before the 1986 annual town
29 meeting in the Town of York; and

30 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
31 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
32 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
33 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
34 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
35 therefore,

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
2 follows:

3 P&SL 1985, c. 57, §2, first sentence, is amended
4 to read:

5 **Sec. 2. Referendum; effective date.** This Act
6 shall be submitted to the legal voters of the York
7 Sewer District at the next ~~townwide election~~ annual
8 meeting in the Town of York after the effective date
9 of this Act.

10 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency
11 cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect
12 when approved.

13 STATEMENT OF FACT

14 The purpose of this bill is reflected in the
15 emergency preamble.
