10 11	Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:
12 13 14	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
15 16 17 18	Whereas, the ability of the Maine Warden Service to protect the fish and wildlife resources of this State requires a highly visable law enforcement effort; and
19 20 21	Whereas, the number of hours that game wardens may work is now controlled by federal law due to a recent United States Supreme Court decision; and
22 23 24 25	Whereas, the use of marked vehicles by game wardens for necessary personal business increases law enforcement visability and serves as a deterrant to would be violators; and
26 27 28	Whereas, wardens have historically apprehended violators and responded to emergencies while using state-owned vehicles for necessary personal use; and
29 30 31	Whereas, the personal use of state-owned vehicles by state law enforcement agencies is already regulated through collective bargaining agreements; and
32 33 34 35	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-

3 4	Further amend the bill by inserting before the Statement of Fact the following:
5 6 7	'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
8	STATEMENT OF FACT
9 10 11	This amendment adds an emergency clause calling for the act to take effect upon approval and an emergency preamble to support the emergency clause.
