1 STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to extend the authority of the municipal officers to designate another person to approve single-event permits to events catered by Class A restaurants, hotels and clubs. This amendment also clarifies that the municipal officers must designate a municipal official as the approval person.
