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7 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1189, L.D.
8 1686, Bill, "AN ACT to Allow Municipal Officers to
9 Delegate their Authority to License Catered
10 Off-premise Functions."

11 Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting
12 clause the following:

13 'Sec. 1. 28 MRSA §801-A, sub-§3, ¶G, as amended
14 by PL 1975, c. 122, §2, is further amended to read:

15 G. Approval by the municipal officers or a mu-
16 nicipal official designated by the municipal
17 officers of the municipality in which the pro-
18 posed additional licensed premises are located.'

19 Further amend the bill in the first line after
20 the enacting clause (page 1, line 23 in L.D.) by in-
21 serting at the beginning the following: 'Sec. 2.'

22 Further amend the bill in subsection 4, in the
23 2nd line (page 1, line 26 in L.D.) by striking out
24 the underlined words "their designee" and inserting
25 in their place the following: 'a municipal official
26 designated by the municipal officers'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this amendment is to extend the
3 authority of the municipal officers to designate an-
4 other person to approve single-event permits to
5 events catered by Class A restaurants, hotels and
6 clubs. This amendment also clarifies that the munic-
7 ipal officers must designate a municipal official as
8 the approval person.
