Southern Penobscot con- sists of the municipalities of Alten, Glenburn, <u>Charleston, Corinth, Levant</u> , Hampden, Hermon, Old Tewn and all municipalities and unorganized territory lying east of these and south of the division of Cen- tral Penobscot. The District Court for Southern Penobscot shall be held at Bangor.
32 33 34 35	22. <u>Western Penobscot</u> . Western Penobscot con- sists of all municipalities in Penobscot County not included within the divisions of Northern, Central or Southern Penobscot and the municipalities of Cam-

 bridge, Detroit, Hartland, Palmyra, Pittsfield,
<u>Ripley and St. Albans in Somerset County</u>. The District Court for Western Penobscot shall be held at Newport.

5 25. <u>Somerset</u>. Somerset consists of the entire 6 Gennty of Semerset <u>municipalities of Harmony, Athens,</u> 7 <u>Cornville, Canaan and all municipalities and unorga-</u> 8 <u>nized territory in Somerset County lying to the west</u> 9 <u>and north</u>. The District Court for Somerset shall be 10 held at Skowhegan.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

12 This bill realigns the judicial divisions of 13 Southern Penobscot, Western Penobscot and Somerset to 14 provide for a more balanced caseload and more conve-15 nience to the public.
